



Information clause on Personal data processing

(for clients/contractors of P&WT)

1. **The administrator of personal data** is Pratt & Whitney Tubes Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Niepołomice, Grabska 4, 32-005 Niepołomice, tel. +48 12 397 10 34, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register, kept by the District Court for Krakow - Śródmieście in Krakow, XII Commercial Department of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0000230639, with share capital: PLN 11,700,000.00, NIP: 6792835716, (hereinafter: the "Company"), Contact details: e-mail address: daneosobowe@prattwhitney.com, by phone at +48 12 397 10 34 or in writing to the address of the registered office.
2. Your personal data will be processed in order to perform the civil law contract concluded with you. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6 (1) (b) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, hereinafter: GDPR. Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to provide them prevents the conclusion of a civil law contract. The Company may process your personal data also in order to perform legal obligations incumbent on it in connection with the implementation of a civil law contract, in particular obligations in the field of accounting and tax settlements and in the scope of fulfilling obligations resulting from specific legal regulations related to military production requiring the provision of m.in citizenship data (legal basis: Article 6 (1) (c) GDPR). The Company may also process your personal data in order to establish, pursue or defend claims between you and the Company (legal basis: Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR). Your personal data may be disclosed to entities providing to the Company, in particular IT, accounting, transport, courier, postal and service services.
3. Your personal data may be transferred to entities located outside the European Economic Area (EEA), i.e. located in Canada and the United States of America on the basis of approved and binding Binding Corporate Rules. 4. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary for the purpose of performing the civil law contract, and then establishing, pursuing or defending claims related to the implementation of the mandate contract, as well as the obligations incumbent on the Company specified in the provisions of generally applicable law, e.g. accounting regulations or taxes.

Your rights:

- a) access to your personal data,
- b) their corrections,
- c) their removal ,
- d) restriction of their processing,
- e) their transfer,
- f) object to the processing if the Company processes it in order to pursue its legitimate interest ,
- g) withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal, if the Company processes it on the basis of your consent .

5. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you consider that the Processing of your personal data by the Company violates the provisions of the GDPR.
